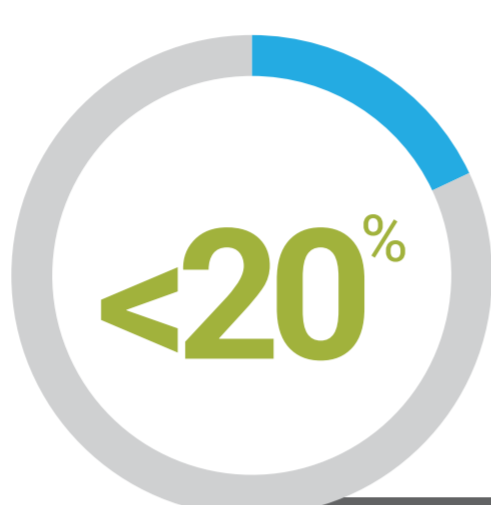




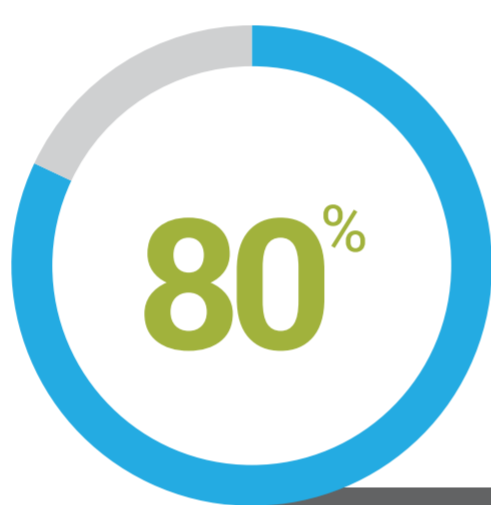
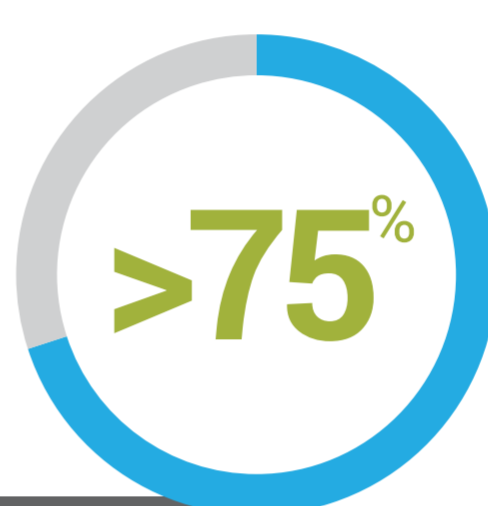
## Cybersecurity Issues & NIST CSF Taking the Pulse of Information Security Leaders

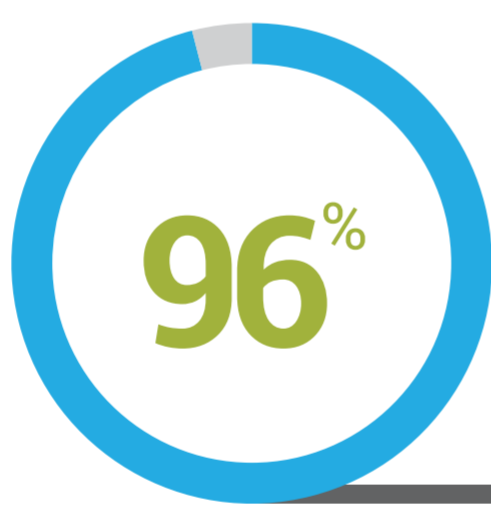
More than half of respondents said less than 20% of their cybersecurity program is automated

More than 75% said demonstrating the state of cybersecurity to the board is a challenge.



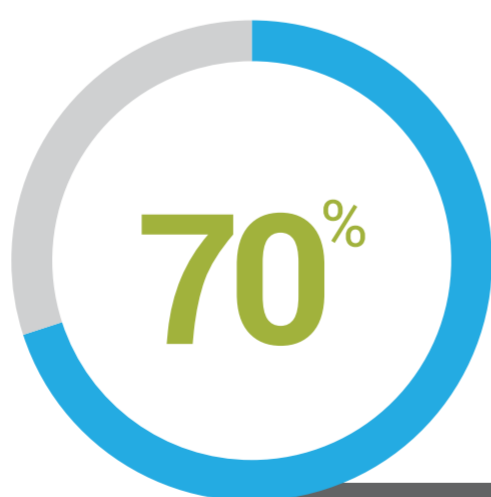
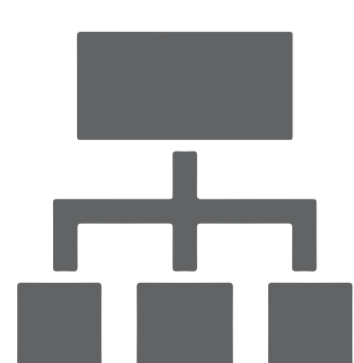
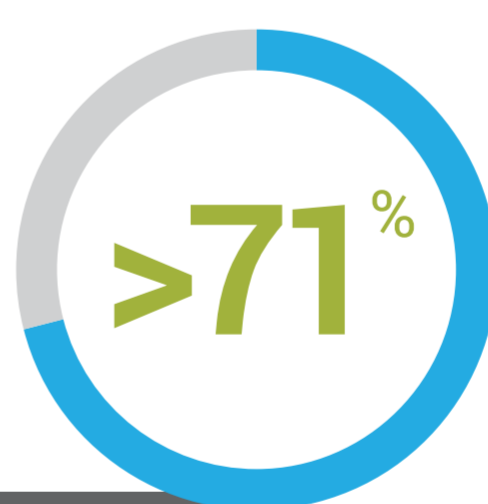
80% agreed that the Board of Directors take an active interest in their cybersecurity program

Only 12% strongly agree they had enough staff to manage their cybersecurity program



96% contend it's important to demonstrate cybersecurity posture to the Board of Directors

71% said their organization is using or planning to use the NIST CSF to determine where cybersecurity budget should be allocated



70% agreed it's important to tie key risk indicators to NIST CSF

96% agreed that the scope of cybersecurity assessments will grow within the next year
